MARINE RESOURCES STUDY

Makua Military Reservation

Purpose/Objectives

The purpose of the 2009 Marine Resources Study, as defined by settlement agreements entered into by the Army and Malama Makua, is to evaluate whether:

- Fish, shellfish, limu (marine algae or seaweed), and other marine resources near Makua Beach or muliwai (estuaries or stream mouths) that area residents rely on for subsistence contain harmful levels of substances associated with proposed military training at Makua;
- There is a potential that Makua Military Reservation (MMR) activities have or will contribute harmful substances to fish, shellfish, limu and other marine resources; and
- The proposed training activities pose a human health risk to area residents who rely on marine resources for subsistence.
