Re-Deployed Unit ECO Program Assistance



USAG-HI, DPW Environmental provides assistance to returning units to re-establish their Environmental Compliance Programs:

- Site Assistance Visits (SAVs)
- Setup unit specific Environmental Compliance Program Book.
- Courtesy Inspections prior to commencement of official inspection schedule.
- On-site, unit/facility specific mandatory training for all unit personnel.
- On-site, unit/facility specific mandatory Senior Leader Environmental Compliance Training (SLECT).
- Re-establish 30-Day Authorized Use List



Common Errors for Returning Units



- Error: Failure to check in with the Environmental Office and appoint and train ECOs.
 - *Result: Program non-existent. Improper HazMat/Waste management. UNSAT inspection/possible HDOH fines.*
- Error: Failure to send senior leaders to the required Senior Leader Environmental Compliance Training (SLECT) IAW USAG-HI-4.
 - *Result: Program lacks leadership and authority. Improper HazMat/Waste management. UNSAT inspection/possible HDOH fines.*
- Error: Failure to establish proper Haz Mat storage and waste collection points.
 - *Result: Improper HazMat/Waste management. UNSAT inspection/possible HDOH fines.*
- Error: Failure to limit Haz Mat supply orders to the required Authorized Use List (AUL) 30-day quantities.
 - *Result: Non-Compliance with USAG-HI AUL Policy. Generate excess waste material. UNSAT inspection/possible HDOH fines.*

ASBESTOS AND LEAD-BASED PAINT CONTAINING MATERIAL

GENERAL INFORMATION

Asbestos & Lead-Based Paint may be found on any building on the installation. Typical asbestos containing material (ACM) include old floor tile, pipe/tank insulation, fire-resistant safes and coatings. Lead is found in the older coats of paint on some of the installations older facilities.

POTENTIAL HAZARDS

Activities such as sanding, grinding, drilling, or sawing of asbestos containing materials or lead based paint are *not allowed*. Self-help removal of asbestos containing tiles is prohibited. Only trained and certified abatement workers may disturb or remove these materials (asbestos, lead). The exposure effects of asbestos and lead are dangerous and can be fatal. There may be increased health risks associated with not following the recommended handling procedures. For additional information contact DPW Environmental Division @ (808-656-100).

WASTE CHARACTERIZATION

Asbestos containing materials are managed as SPECIAL WASTES. Lead based paint waste is managed as HAZARDOUS WASTE.

HANDLING AND DISPOSAL PROCEDURES

Step 1 Contact DPW Environmental Division @ (808-656-3100).

Step 2 A survey may be conducted, laboratory testing may be required and abatement may be conducted by qualified personnel.
