Acceptable Items

-  Dry corrugated cardboard
-  Paperboard (i.e. cereal boxes)
-  Newspaper (color sections ok)
-  Glossy paper, magazines
-  White & color paper (segregated)
-  Phone books
-  Shredded paper (bagged)
-  Hard plastics 1-5
-  Shrink wrap
-  Toner cartridges
-  Scrap metal
-  Green waste (call ARC first)
-  HI-5 beverage containers (glass, plastic, aluminum)
-  Non HI-5 glass
-  Tin cans
-  Wood pallets/wood waste (untreated, no paint, no metal)

Keep in mind that acceptable items are subject to change based on site capacity, restrictions, funding, etc.

Unacceptable Items

-  Appliances
-  Fire extinguishers
-  Trash
-  Fluorescent bulbs
-  Vehicle tires (take to Firestone)
-  Furniture, mattresses
-  Batteries
-  Hazardous waste
-  Air conditioners/refrigerators (call DPW shops)

Residents should call their local Community Center for proper disposal.
