


Using DTP with MS Vista


DTP will work in the Vista environment; however, there are additional steps during the installation process to enable that functionality.

The installation process is still with "Typical" options, but the DTP must be installed to the "C:\Users\Public\DTP" folder. Please follow these steps:


- a. Download the correct DTP Setup.exe file for your branch and component of service.
- b. Double-click on the "Setup.Exe" file, select "Typical", and click "Next":




- c. The installation process lists the default location for the DTP. Select the "Browse" button:




d. Scroll up the folder list and click on the “C:\Users”, then click on the “Public” folder.




e. Add “DTP” to the end of the Path as shown:




f. Click on the “Ok” button, and the installation screen should look like this:



g. Click on the “Next” button, and the screen should look like this:



h. Click "Next" to continue the installation process until complete:
