MEMORANDUM FOR All Military Personnel, Department of Defense (DoD) Civilian Employees and Contractors within United States Army Garrison, Hawaii (USAG-HI), Installations

SUBJECT: Policy Memorandum USAG-HI-6, Environmental Policy

1. References.

a. Army Regulation 200-1, Environmental Protection and Enhancement, 13 Dec 07.

b. Department of Defense Guidance for Executive Order 13693: Planning for Federal Sustainability in the Next Decade, 29 Mar 16.

2. The purpose of the environmental policy statement is to drive the improvement of the Army's environmental performance throughout the USAG-HI and US Army Hawaii organization. The policy reflects the commitment of our senior leaders to comply with applicable legal and other requirements, to prevent pollution, and to continually improve our environmental awareness and compliance with AR-201. The environmental policy is the basis upon which environmental strategies and goals are set.

3. The enclosed environmental policy applies to all Soldiers, Civilians, Family members, contractors, and other personnel who work on, reside on, or visit any US Army installation, facility, or worksite in the State of Hawaii. The Garrison mission assimilates the principles of this policy into daily decision making.

4. The USAG-HI mission is to support each Warrior, Family, and Community with sustainable services, ensuring power projection readiness from Hawaii. Environmental stewardship is an integral part of enabling current and future mission requirements.

5. This policy memorandum shall be given the widest dissemination. It shall be posted in all shops, work areas, and on all official bulletin boards as appropriate. This policy is maintained for viewing by the public and all person's working on the behalf of the U.S. Army Hawaii at www.garrison.hawaii.army.mil/command/documents.htm.

6. This policy supersedes Policy Memorandum USAG-HI-10, dated 19 May 2014 and remains in effect until cancelled or superseded in writing.
