

## SUBJECT: DPW Demand Maintenance Order Technicians and phone line

DPW Customers have experienced very long wait times when calling in Demand Maintenance Orders (DMOs). DPW has 3 vacancies for Demand Maintenance Order (DMO) Technicians. Selections for these vacancies have been made, however the new employees have not started work yet. DPW has temporarily reassigned personnel to partially cover the phones. The second problem we have discovered is that the phone system itself is malfunctioning, dropping the customer's call while keeping the customer's phone ringing which causes the customer to think that Technicians are not answering the phone. Phone system is in the process of being replaced, however in interim we ask that:

If the Demand Maintenance Order telephone call is not answered in the first 20 rings, hang up and call again.

Please do not call the DMO line to ask for status of your DMO. 60% of the calls received are asking for status, not calling in DMOs. DMO status questions should go to your DPW Facility Manager.

In the near future, DPW is working on putting non emergency DMO requests on the Garrison Website so that customers can email non emergency DMOs to DPW. Emergency DMOs will still be taken over the telephone.



# Repair Building 750



## Schofield Barracks



### Description of Work

- Repair (3) latrines and modify Offices
- Retile lanai
- Replace six AC units
- Install ADA doors and ramps
- Renovate 2<sup>nd</sup> floor admin area and repair sagging floors due to termite damage

### Current Status

- Repair (3) latrines: 100% Complete 23 DEC 2015; Office Renovations Remain – Mod being processed - \$220K
- Retile lanai – 100% Complete - \$105K
- Replace 6 AC Units – \$647K, 50% complete. Two units remain. ECD 29 JUL 2016
- Install ADA doors/ramps: 75% Complete \$132K, Two doors remain. ECD 20 MAY 2016

### Way Ahead

- Repairs to 2<sup>nd</sup> floor to begin following admin area reconfiguration. Space must be reconfigured to be used as swing space while termite damaged area of 2<sup>nd</sup> floor is under repair.

- Install concrete walkway to parking lot
- Install new stamped concrete floor for portico entrance.
- Install irrigated 4 feet wide planter bed with low groundcover and cinder mulch.
- Install drainage system to improve storm water runoff.
- Provide new turf for all disturbed areas not paved or planted with groundcover.
- Relayout and restripe parking area

- REC/Section 106 Completed 15 SEP 2015
- Design/Bid/Build Awarded 22 DEC 2015
- Pre-Construction Meeting: 12 MAY 2016
- Design Cost: \$297.5K
- Construction: \$2,207,225
