Private Organizations and Fundraising

A **Private Organization** is a self-sustaining, non-federal entity constituted or established and operated by individuals acting outside any official capacity.

- Each Private Organization (PO) must register to operate on the installation
 - Process can take a minimum of 90 days.
- Continuity a must during change in officers (pass down information and processes)
- PO must comply with regulatory requirements
 - Submit regular reporting requirements
 - Submit details / requests for events open to the public
 - Request approval for fundraisers
 - PO may not use government resources and / or official status

Fundraising

- Fundraising within a unit's footprint is approved by the Unit Commander with Staff Judge Advocate concurrence
- Fundraising outside unit's footprint is approved by Director, Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation
- Units and Family Readiness Groups may not fundraise off post
- POs may conduct one general public fundraiser a year with approval from Garrison Commander
- Garrison Commander approves all PO-initiated fundraising events


Grass Cutting Responsibilities

Grass cutting accomplished by Military Units, DPW, Contracts, DPTMS, RCI Housing, MEDCOM, & tenant organizations.

IMCOM ceasing DPW in-house (O&M) grass cutting starting in FY19. Existing DPW contract will remain in place to cut grass by contract but cannot be increased to include DPW O&M portion.

New Hours and Procedures

- **0800 – 0900** Group Brief for Departure Temporary Lodging Allowance (TLA)
- **0900 – 1100** Group Brief for Arrival Temporary Lodging Allowance (TLA)
- **1100 – 1200** Group Brief for Renewal Temporary Lodging Allowance (TLA)
- **1100 – 1400** A total of 20 walk-ins will be accepted for the following (No TLA):
 - Housing Search Info
 - Questions/Misc
 - Utility Waivers
 - Inbound/Outbound Stamp
- **1400 Closed**



HSO Documents Required

ARRIVAL TLA:

- PCS orders and all amendments
- DA Form 31 (showing you signed in off leave into the command)
- Flight itinerary for service members and family members



HSO Documents Required

DEPARTURE TLA:

- PCS orders and all amendments
- DA Form 31 signed and must have a control number
- DD 1299 (household goods packing and pick-up)
- Flight itinerary for service members and family members
- Termination of on-post housing or final inspection schedule from your community center



HSO Documents Required

RENEWAL TLA:

- Housing search sheet
- On post housing offer, signed lease or purchase agreement

**PLEASE HAVE SOLDIERS BRING A COPY OF ALL
REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR HSO TO KEEP**



Unaccompanied Personnel Housing

- **USAG-HI Policy #39, Unaccompanied Personnel Housing is now signed and in effect**
 - Unit Barracks Management Representatives given a copy
 - Will be posted on the Garrison website shortly
 - Please review the new policy



Unaccompanied Personnel Housing

- **Soldiers Who Divorce**

- The date the divorce is final a Certificate of Non-Availability (CNA) is required to remain off-post
- Soldiers pending a divorce should not enter into a new lease agreement without an approved CNA
- Soldiers must submit requests through unit Chain-of-Command via their Barracks Management Representative (BMR)
- The Approval Authority to live off-post is the Garrison Commander
 - Only the Garrison Commander has this authority



Unaccompanied Personnel Housing

- **Geographical Bachelors**
 - Soldiers who are *voluntarily* separated from their families
 - Require an Exception to Policy (ETP) approved by the Garrison Commander to reside in the barracks
 - Minimum adequacy standards do not apply
 - May be required to vacate barracks if space is required for single Soldiers
 - A Certificate of Non-Availability (CNA) is not required to reside off-post



Community Updates

- **Community Improvements On-going**
 - Santa Fe Phase II—commencing 22 Aug
 - Roof repairs, vinyl fences, grey rock installation and sidewalk repairs
 - Solomon Vinyl Fencing continuing in the Kalakaua
 - 62% Complete—expected completion end of Sep
 - Mendonca homes in Canby community
 - Grey Rock installation 100% complete
 - Painting and Vinyl Fencing commencing 6 Sep



Community Updates

- HMR Improvements
 - Roofing 100% complete
 - Vinyl fencing 73% complete
 - Painting 58% complete
 - Grey rock installation 63% complete
- Building Energy Management Systems (BEMS)
 - Estimated completion date of 20 Sep

DES Update



Indicators of Suspicious Activity or Behavior (What to Report)

- Individuals drawing pictures or taking notes in an area not normally of interest to a tourist or showing unusual interest in or photographing security cameras, guard locations, or watching security reaction drills and procedures
- Multiple sightings of the same suspicious person, vehicle, or activity, separated by time, distance, or direction
- Briefcase, backpack, suitcase, or package left unattended
- Vehicle parked in NO PARKING ZONES in front of an important building
- People in restricted areas where they are not supposed to be

- Individuals who don't fit into the surrounding environment because they are wearing improper attire for the location or season
- Individuals who exhibit suspicious behavior, such as staring or quickly looking away from individuals or vehicles as they enter or leave facilities or parking area
- People asking questions about security forces, security measures, or sensitive information
- Chemical smells or fumes that worry you
- People purchasing supplies or equipment that can be used to make bombs
- People purchasing weapons or uniforms without proper credentials





Where to Report:

- Military Police
- Local law enforcement
- Security forces
- Army Counterintelligence

How to Report:

- Date and time activity occurred
- Where activity occurred
- Physical descriptions of the people involved
- Description of the vehicle(s) involved
- What type of activity
- Describe what you saw or heard
- Provide pictures if you took any





Schofield Barracks Running Routes






