

**SUBJECT: Traffic Modifications at Lyman/Flagler Intersection, SB**

There will be traffic modifications at the intersection of Lyman and Flagler in order to widen Lyman Road, add a dedicated left turn lane, and add traffic and pedestrian signals to the intersection. Construction will be phased so road widening will be performed first providing an additional lane. The majority of the project will allow traffic to flow in both directions of Lyman and Flagler. Flagmen will be used as necessary. Turns will be limited at the intersection to provide two lanes of traffic. Work will be taking place from 22 Feb 16 – 12 Aug 2016. Work will be performed from 0700-1600 Monday through Friday excluding holidays. The contractor will have appropriate signs and barriers for lane closure and traffic diversion of the roadway. 


  - Street light repairs are complete in the North Region




## Canby/Wheeler Split A/C Installation Project Update






# Visual Depiction of AMR Incidents
