



Federal Impact Aid Survey Cards 2015

- On September 2, 2015, the Federal Survey Card will be distributed to all Hawaii public school students.
- Students and parents are highly encouraged to return the completed card to the child's school the very next day.

WHAT IS FEDERAL IMPACT AID?

- Impact Aid is a partial reimbursement from the Federal Government to reimburse school districts that have lost tax revenues due to a federal presence and have incurred the cost of providing educational services for federally-connected students.
- Impact Aid funding supports substitute teacher salaries, subsidizes utility, student transportation and facility maintenance costs, and is used to purchase Common Core materials.
- The average cost to educate a student in the Hawaii Department of Education:
 - Per pupil cost = \$13,000
 - Federal Impact Aid reimbursement = \$2000 or 15% of the total cost
