Back to School

- There will be a significant increase in traffic entering the installations compared to what we have seen over the past two months
- Expect and plan for additional times to enter and traverse the installations, especially from 0700 to 0830 and 1330 to 1430 during school days. (Wednesday is early release with increased traffic flow from 1230 to 1330)
- Parking remains at a premium; remember that parking around the schools illegally may block the view of parents and children crossing the street or the view of approaching drivers
- Military Police will be surging around the schools at the beginning of the school year until traffic and pedestrians get back into the routine of school day traffic.

Career Skill Program

Career Skills Programs (CSPs) offer employment skills training opportunities to Soldiers preparing to transition (within 180 days of ETS) from military to civilian employment

- CSP provides credentialing, job training, apprenticeships and internships for transitioning Soldiers
- Designed to facilitate the transition from Soldier to Civilian while affording the Soldier the greatest potential for employment after successful completion.

“CSP aims to set conditions for post-service excellent careers and decrease high unemployment compensation (UCX) paid to veterans”




