






FT. SHAFTER (FS)



Housing Services Office

Temporary Lodging Allowance (TLA)

- Please ensure that inbound/outbound Soldiers make HSO a first stop to fully understand TLA authorization
 - Patience is greatly appreciated as wait times can be up to 2+ hours
 - Due to reduced staffing levels
 - Please ensure Soldiers bring all required documents
 - HSO does not print or make copies due to time constraints
 - We are working on efficiencies



Unaccompanied Personnel Housing

Authority to live off-post (Certificate of Non-availability)

- HQDA is scrutinizing issuance of CNA's
 - Due to downsizing and barracks utilization
- Soldiers must submit requests through unit Chain-of-Command via their Barracks Management Representative (BMR)
- The “Approval Authority” to live off-post is the GC
 - Only the GC has this authority
 - Soldiers shall not move off-post without the GC approval
 - Please ensure the CNA request has detailed justification



Community Updates
