Schofield Barracks

Road Closure at Leilehua Ave

SB

19 October 2015 – 21 December 2015 (24 hours, 7 Days a week)

Phase 1
Leilehua Ave between Macomb Road and Kline/Gordon Lane will be closed from 19-25 November 2015. The lanes highlighted in yellow between Leilehua Ave and Waianae Ave will be made 2-way for residents only. Closures will be 24/7. On the lanes highlighted in yellow, there will be no parking on the Leilehua bound side of the road and no parking within 100 ft from Leilehua Ave.

Curb Work
Concrete curb repair will be performed from 19 October – 18 November 2015. There will be moving lane closures along Leilehua Ave. Flagmen will direct traffic.

Phase 2
Leilehua Ave between the Kline/Gordon Lane and the Stoneman Field Road will be closed from 30 November 2015 to 4 December 2015. There will be no access to the parking of SB 645, Family and Child Care. The lanes highlighted in yellow between Leilehua Ave and Waianae Ave will be made 2-way for residents only. Closures will be 24/7. On the lanes highlighted in yellow, there will be no parking on the Leilehua bound side of the road and no parking within 100 ft from Leilehua Ave.

Phase 3
Leilehua Ave between McCormack and the Stoneman Field Road be closed from 7-11 December 2015. The lanes highlighted in yellow between Leilehua Ave and Waianae Ave will be made 2-way for residents only. Closures will be 24/7. On the lanes highlighted in yellow, there will be no parking on the Leilehua bound side of the road and no parking within 100 ft from Leilehua Ave.

Top Lift Paving Phase A
Leilehua Ave between Macomb and Morris/McAndrew will be closed on 14 December 2015 (orange). The lanes between Leilehua Ave and Waianae Ave highlighted in blue will be made 2-way for residents only. The closures will be from 0800-1630

Top Lift Paving Phase B
Leilehua Ave between Morris/McAndrew and McCormack will be closed on 15 December 2015 (red). The lanes between Leilehua Ave and Waianae Ave highlighted in yellow will be made 2-way for residents only. The closures will be from 0800-1630

Striping
Striping will be performed from 16-17 December 2015. There will be moving lane closures along Leilehua Ave. Flagmen will direct traffic.

Note:
During Top Lift Paving Phase A, there will be no parking in the Leilehua bound direction of the blue lanes and no parking within 100 ft of Leilehua Ave. During Top Lift Paving Phase B, there will be no parking in the Leilehua bound direction of the yellow lanes and no parking within 100 ft of Leilehua Ave.




Canby/Wheeler Split A/C Installation Project Update

- Install 210 split AC systems in IPC Historic homes
 - Installation period Apr 2015-Apr 2017
 - Cost of \$2.9M (approx. \$14k per home)
- IPC will continue to install split AC systems as homes vacate
- Occupied Canby homes installation delayed due to backorder of A/C units
 - **Scheduled installation will commence on 2 Nov**
 - 2 homes per week until completion
- Wheeler split A/C installation on occupied homes will commence when Canby is complete or if there is an extenuating circumstance

Canby Renovations

- \$16.9M project (Jul 2015-Dec 2018)
 - Remodels kitchen in Canby Stuccos
 - As homes vacate
 - Remodels kitchen/master bedroom in Woodies
 - Prototype in progress
 - Historic consult pending
 - As homes vacate
 - Provides off-street parking
 - Provides new roofs



Additional Working Projects

- **Playground Projects - \$2.1M**
 - 13 of 15 new playgrounds complete
 - 5 remaining of 60 rehabilitated in progress
- **Roofing & Painting & Fencing - \$7.5M**
 - Legacy neighborhoods throughout the North and South
 - 136 New Roofs (HMR)
 - 279 Homes Painted (HMR)
- **Demolished 192 homes in Santa Fe**
 - 187 new construction in Fall 2016



Approved Projects--5 Year Capital Plan

- **\$29M** from 2016-2020
 - \$3.9m paving projects
 - \$9.75m painting projects (1868 homes)
 - \$4.75m fencing projects (1280 homes)
 - \$10.8m roofing projects (801 homes)

• Authorized Trick or Treat hours for all Community Housing Areas are 1800 to 2100 on 31 October 2014
