

Simplified Plan Phase #2 for Traffic Control in SB





Canby/Wheeler Split A/C installation project update

- Install 210 split AC systems in IPC Historic homes
 - Installation period Apr 2015-Apr 2017
 - Cost of \$2.9M (approx. \$14k per home)
- IPC to install split AC systems as homes vacate
- Occupied homes split AC installation to commence Sept. 2015
 - Occupants received notifications and opt in/out surveys 9/4/15
 - Survey results are still being received and remaining residents are being contacted that have not yet responded.
 - 26 surveys received from Canby Woodies
 - 6 surveys from Canby Stuccos -2 Opt out
- Homes completed to date:
 - 43 of 94 Canby Woodies
 - 24 of 35 Canby Stuccos
 - 44 of 81 Wheeler



Canby/Wheeler Split A/C installation project update


Schofield Barracks - Canby & General's Lp Neighborhoods

Halloween Safety

The Directorate of Emergency Services (DES) will provide increased security presence in the community during Trick or Treat hours. As always, the community should feel free to approach any military or DA police officer with issues/concerns.

- Military Police personnel will hand out chemical-light souvenirs to children over the course of the evening.
- Parents are strongly encouraged to have children carry a flashlight or a chemical-light.
- Parents should dress children in light colored clothing or sew reflectors on dark clothing.

DES recommends that parents remind their children out trick or treating alone, to think about safety:

- Wait for proper traffic signals and stay on the sidewalk whenever possible
- If there is no sidewalk, walk on the left side of the roadway facing traffic
- Look both ways before crossing the street and use crosswalks
- Never enter vehicles or homes when invited by a stranger


