SCHOFIELD BARRACKS, Hawaii — U.S. Army Garrison, Hawaii (USAG-HI) will hold a Memorial Day Remembrance Ceremony at 9 a.m., May 30, at the Schofield Barracks Post Cemetery.

The public is invited to join the garrison as it honors Soldiers who gave their lives in service of our country.

Col. Douglas S. Mulbury, commander, USAG-HI, will be the speaker for this event. Representatives from the Military Order of the Purple Heart, Disabled American Veterans, Veterans of Foreign Wars, and American Legion will also participate, helping place wreaths in the cemetery to honor fallen comrades.

Drivers should allow for extra time due to heightened security measures in effect.

Non-military affiliated guests wishing to attend this event must enter through Schofield Barracks' Lyman Gate, off Kunia Road. Vehicles without a current military decal (DD Form 2220) or Army installation pass will be issued a temporary pass at the Lyman Gate Visitor Control Center.

In addition, all occupants 16 years of age and older must present a valid government form of identification, such as a drivers license or state ID card.
