Convoy advisory for Central Oahu, Honolulu

SCHOFIELD BARRACKS, Hawaii – The Army is advising motorists to be alert and drive with care as the 25th Infantry Division conducts a series of convoys on Oahu this week.

Convoys are as follows:

- **Aug. 21** - Convoy from Schofield Barracks to Honolulu Harbor, between 9 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. Vehicles will travel via H2, H1 and Nimitz Highway.
- **Aug. 21, 23 and 25** - Convoys from Schofield Barracks to Pearl Harbor (Waipio Point) between 7 p.m. and 10 p.m. Vehicles will travel via H2 and Farrington Highway.

Each daily convoy consists of approximately 50 military vehicles of varying sizes. The vehicles will depart in groups of 10, at staggered intervals, as a safe-driving precaution.

The Army is coordinating this effort with the Hawaii Department of Transportation.

The 25th Infantry Division's 2nd Stryker Brigade is transporting the vehicles and equipment in preparation for upcoming training at Pōhakuloa Training Area on Hawai'i Island.
