## **Noise Advisory for Waipahu**

**WHEELER ARMY AIRFIELD, Hawaii** – Waipahu area residents may experience an increase in aviation noise during the mornings of Aug. 27 and 28, as new UH-60 Black Hawks are moved from Pearl Harbor to Wheeler Army Airfield.

The movement dates are subject to change and are contingent on environmental conditions that may affect the arrival of the new Black Hawks into port. The flights are scheduled to begin after 7 a.m.

Flight plans are subject to change due to weather conditions. However, the aircraft will stay at or above 1,500 feet, when possible, to lessen potential noise impacts on the surrounding community.

The routes and procedures comply with Federal Aviation Administration regulations.

The Army in Hawaii appreciates the community's understanding and continued support of local Soldiers and their families. While sometimes loud, the sounds of aviation represent how the Army ensures our nation's Soldiers are ready to accomplish the mission and defend the Pacific.
