Convoy advisory for Central Oahu, Honolulu

SCHOFIELD BARRACKS, Hawaii – The Army is advising motorists to be alert and drive with care as the 25th Infantry Division conducts a series of convoys from Pearl Harbor to Schofield Barracks, Sept. 14-22.

- Sept. 14 - Convoy from Pearl Harbor to Schofield Barracks via Farrington Highway and the H2 freeway between 12 p.m. and 1:30 p.m.
- Sept. 16 - Convoy from Pearl Harbor to Schofield Barracks via Farrington Highway and the H2 freeway between 12 p.m. and 1:30 p.m.
- Sept. 18 - Convoy from Pearl Harbor to Schofield Barracks via Farrington Highway and the H2 freeway between 12 p.m. and 1:30 p.m.
- Sept. 20 - Convoy from Pearl Harbor to Schofield Barracks via Farrington Highway and the H2 freeway between 12 p.m. and 1:30 p.m.
- Sept. 22 - Convoy from Pearl Harbor to Schofield Barracks via Farrington Highway and the H2 freeway between 12 p.m. and 1:30 p.m.

Each daily convoy consists of approximately 50 military vehicles of varying size. The vehicles will depart in groups of 10, at staggered intervals, as a safe-driving precaution.

The Army is coordinating this effort with the Hawaii Department of Transportation.

The 25th Infantry Division's 2nd Stryker Brigade is transporting the vehicles and equipment following three weeks of training at Pōhakuloa Training Area on Hawai'i Island.
