Convoy advisory for Central Oahu, Honolulu

SCHOFIELD BARRACKS, Hawaii – The Army is advising motorists to be alert and drive with care as the 25th Infantry Division conducts a series of convoys from Schofield Barracks to Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam, Sept. 26-29.

- Sept. 26 - Convoy from Schofield Barracks to JBPH-H via H2 and the H1 freeways between 4 a.m. and 7 a.m., 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., 7 p.m. and 11:59 p.m.
- Sept. 27 - Convoy from Schofield Barracks to JBPH-H via H2 and the H1 freeways between 12 a.m. and 7 a.m., 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., 7 p.m. and 11:59 p.m.
- Sept. 28 - Convoy from Schofield Barracks to JBPH-H via H2 and the H1 freeways between 12 a.m. and 7 a.m., 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., 7 p.m. and 11:59 p.m.
- Sept. 29 - Convoy from Schofield Barracks to JBPH-H via H2 and the H1 freeways between 12 a.m. and 7 a.m.

No convoys will be on the roads during peak traffic periods from 7 a.m. and 9 a.m., and 5 p.m. and 7 p.m.

Each daily convoy consists of approximately 5-7 military vehicles of varying size departing at staggered intervals, as a safe-driving precaution.

The 25th Infantry Division's 3rd Brigade Combat Team is transporting vehicles, equipment and personnel for training.
