Noise Advisory for Schofield Barracks

SCHOFIELD BARRACKS, Hawaii – Residents in the vicinity of Schofield Barracks may experience periodic increases in noise Sept. 26, as a result of scheduled training exercises, here.

The training, consisting of artillery fire will be conducted from approximately 7 a.m.-3 p.m.

The effects of training vary depending on weather, as overcast conditions may increase noise and vibrations. Training is subject to change and dependent on required environmental conditions, such as wind speed and moisture level. Smoke may be visible for a short time; however, there is no immediate danger.

The Army in Hawaii appreciates the community's understanding and continued support of local Soldiers and their families. While sometimes loud, the sounds of training represent how the Army ensures our nation's Soldiers are ready to accomplish the mission and return home safely.
