Noise Advisory for Wheeler Army Airfield

SCHOFIELD BARRACKS, Hawaii – Residents on Wheeler Army Airfield and the surrounding community can expect an increase in noise Dec. 16 between approximately 11 a.m. and 2 p.m, due to the scheduled landing of an Air Force C-17 Globemaster III, here.

Landing the cargo aircraft at Wheeler is part of a joint training endeavor with the 25th Infantry Division, the 5th Battlefield Coordination Detachment and the Air Force's 15th Wing.

The training is contingent on weather that could impact visibility or safe runway conditions.

The Army in Hawaii appreciates the community's understanding and continued support of local Soldiers and their families. While sometimes loud, the sounds of training represent how the Army ensures our nation's Soldiers are ready to accomplish their mission and return home safely.
