## **Noise advisory for Schofield training**

**SCHOFIELD BARRACKS, Hawaii** – Residents in the immediate vicinity of Schofield Barracks may experience an increase in noise as a result of Marine Corps and Hawaii Army National Guard field artillery training exercises, here, June 10-21, between the hours of approximately 8 a.m.-9 p.m.

The Marines will conduct their field artillery training exercise, June 10-14, and the Guardsmen will conduct their field artillery training exercise, June 11-21.

The effects of training vary depending on weather conditions. Overcast conditions may increase noise and vibrations. Smoke may be visible for a short time; however, there is no immediate danger.

The military services in Hawaii appreciate the community's understanding and continued support of local service members and families. While sometimes loud, the sounds of training represent how the military ensures the nation's service members are ready to accomplish the mission and return home safely.
