Noise advisory for Mililani Mauka, Wahiawa areas

SCHOFIELD BARRACKS, Hawaii – Residents in Mililani Mauka and Wahiawa areas may experience intermittent noise as a result of training exercises, here, June 25-26.

The 25th Infantry Division’s 2nd Brigade Combat Team will be conducting combat engineer training exercises at various times between the hours of 7:30 a.m.-6 p.m.

The effects of training vary depending on weather conditions. Overcast conditions may increase noise and vibrations.

While sometimes loud, the sounds of training represent how the military ensures the nation's service members are ready to accomplish the mission and return home safely.
