Noise Advisory for Schofield Barracks

SCHOFIELD BARRACKS, Hawaii – Residents in the vicinity of Schofield Barracks may experience periodic increases in noise April 2-3, from approximately 5 p.m. to 6 a.m. as a result of scheduled night training here.

The training consists of small arms and mortar fire conducted by the 3rd Brigade Combat Team, 25th Infantry Division to certify mortar crews on their weapon systems.

Please note, training date is subject to change. Training is contingent on required environmental condition, such as wind speed and moisture levels. Additionally, overcast conditions may increase noise and vibrations. Smoke may be visible for a short time; however there is no immediate danger.

The Army in Hawaii appreciates the community's understanding and continued support of local Soldiers and their families. While sometimes loud, the sounds of training represent how the Army ensures our nation's Soldiers are ready to accomplish the mission and return home safely.
