Noise Advisory for Schofield Training

SCHOFIELD BARRACKS, Hawaii – Residents in the vicinity of Schofield Barracks may experience periodic increases in noise Dec.9-12, from approximately 5 p.m. to 6 a.m. as a result of scheduled night training here. The training consists of small arms and mortar fire conducted by the Army and the U.S. Marine Corps to certify crews on their weapon systems.

Please note that training dates are subject to change and effects of training vary depending on weather conditions. Overcast conditions may increase noise and vibrations. Smoke may be visible for a short time; however, there is no immediate danger.

The Army in Hawaii appreciates the community's understanding and continued support of local Soldiers and their families. While sometimes loud, the sounds of these weapons represent how the Army ensures our nation's Soldiers are ready to accomplish any mission.
