SCHOFIELD BARRACKS, Hawaii (May 21, 2015) – The Army will hold an intimate Memorial Day Remembrance Ceremony, May 25 at 10 a.m., at the Post Cemetery, here.

The public is invited to join the Army community in Hawaii as they honor Army veterans and members of our sister services who gave their lives in service of our country.

Col. Richard A. Fromm, commander, U.S. Army Garrison-Hawaii, will be the speaker for this event. Representatives from the Military Order of the Purple Heart, Disabled American Veterans, and Veterans of Foreign Wars will also participate, placing wreaths to honor fallen comrades.

Visitors who do not possess a military ID should enter Schofield through Lyman Gate on Kunia Road, where they will be subject to an installation security background check. All vehicle occupants 16 years of age and older must present a valid state or government photo ID, and the vehicle driver must provide a current driver's license, vehicle registration, proof of insurance and safety check.
