## September training advisory for Schofield Barracks

**SCHOFIELD BARRACKS, Hawaii** (Sept. 2, 2016) — Local military units are scheduled to conduct various training here in September that may be heard by surrounding communities.

For the community's awareness, the training is as follows: (Please note, all training dates are subject to change based on environmental and other factors.)

### September

- Sept. 1-2: Army artillery training
- Sept. 1-5 Marines mortar training
- Sept. 6: Army mortar training
- Sept. 3-7: Marines artillery training
- Sept. 15-16: Army demolitions training
- Sept. 15-30: Army artillery, mortar, and helicopter gunnery training
- Sept. 5-30: Army Lightning Academy training with blank ammunition and explosive simulators on East Range. Training will occur during daytime and nighttime hours.

Weather, such as overcast conditions, can increase noise and vibrations. Should individuals hear noise, there is no immediate danger.

The military services in Hawaii appreciate the community's understanding and continued support for local military training. While sometimes loud, the sounds of training represent how the military ensures the nation's service members are ready to accomplish the mission and return home safely.
