Training advisory for Pohakuloa

POHAKULOA TRAINING AREA, Hawaii – Service members are scheduled to conduct training here, Feb. 19 through March 4, that may be heard by surrounding communities.

These training activities include aircraft and artillery fire. Dates are subject to change based on environmental and other factors.

Intermittent training noise may be heard in surrounding communities. If individuals hear noise or see smoke, there is no immediate danger. Weather, such as overcast conditions, can increase noise and vibrations.

The military services in Hawaii appreciate the community's understanding and continued support of local service members and families. While sometimes loud, the sounds of training represent how the military ensures the nation's service members are ready to accomplish the mission and return home safely.
