- A species survey was conducted at the proposed IPBA preferred alternative location identifying four listed plant species
- These species were found in low numbers because the proposed IPBA location at PTA does not offer the right environmental conditions for them to flourish. These plants are found on other locations in greater numbers on the Big Island, or have been reproduced in PTAs greenhouse.
