

CARDBOARD

GENERAL INFORMATION

Corrugated cardboard is recyclable and is accepted at the Army Recycling Center (ARC). It is made of a sheet of corrugated fiber paper between sheets of cardboard; commonly used to make shipping boxes.

WASTE CHARACTERIZATION

All dry corrugated cardboard is recyclable. Cardboard contaminated with cooking oil, wax, food, oil and fuel stains, cannot be recycled and should be disposed of in an appropriate garbage container.

HANDLING AND DISPOSAL PROCEDURES

Recycle corrugated cardboard with the ARC. Cardboard should NOT be placed in or around dumpsters. Breakdown cardboard boxes to flatten and place in the designated containers or bins labeled “cardboard.” If cardboard containers or bins are not available, keep stacked in dry place and request pick-up by calling the ARC or online at: <https://dpwhawaii.army.mil/PickUp> or bring flattened, dry cardboard boxes to the Recycling Center.
