GENERAL INFORMATION

Magazines are recyclable and are accepted at the Army Recycling Center (ARC).

Magazines and glossy paper can be recycled to make other paper products, saving 60% of the energy it takes to make new paper. (source: earth911.com)

WASTE CHARACTERIZATION

Magazines are made of paper that has been coated. This glossy coating makes the paper good for color printing, graphics and photographs.

Glossy paper, brochures and catalogs are recycled with magazines.

HANDLING AND DISPOSAL PROCEDURES

Recycle magazines along with brochures and glossy paper. Place these items in recycling bins designated for magazine recycling. DO NOT place in white office paper bags or bins. Recycling bins can be requested by contacting the Army Recycling Center.
