## HANDLING AND DISPOSAL PROCEDURES

Recyclable materials should be placed in designated recycling bins/containers, **NOT** in refuse containers or dumpsters. If recycling bins are not available, stack the materials neatly away from refuse dumpsters until it can be taken to the Army Recycling Center or picked-up.
