

WOOD WASTE

GENERAL INFORMATION

Wood waste is recyclable and is accepted at the Army Recycling Center (ARC). The recycled wood is chipped and composted with green waste and other organic material.

WASTE CHARACTERIZATION

Recyclable wood can be pallets, crates, virgin wood, lumber, shavings and saw dust. The wood must **NOT** be treated or painted and must **NOT** contain metal banding or cables, metal fasteners larger than a nail; nails are okay.

HANDLING AND DISPOSAL PROCEDURES

Recycle acceptable wood waste with the Army Recycling Center. Wood must **NOT** be treated or painted. Painted or treated wood can not be recycled and should be disposed as Construction Demolition (C&D) waste. Contact the DPW Service Contracts Branch for more information. All metal bandings and bolts are to be removed and recycled (See Scrap Metal Fact Sheet). Recyclable wood waste is accepted by the Army Recycling Center in limited quantities. Please call the ARC ahead before taking your wood waste. Pick-up service not available for wood waste.
